Mixed Blessings

Good news can be unsettling if it is accompanied by unexpected or difficult circumstances. Learning that the promotion requires a move to another city or the cure will come only with a long and painful treatment can be a mixed blessing and leave us feeling overwhelmed and alone. At such times, we need someone who understands our situation to help us process the information, plan a strategy for breaking the news to others, and deal with the day-to-day realities of what is coming.

As recorded in Luke 1, immediately after Mary receives the surprising news that she will conceive the Son of God as an unwed virgin, she hurries to the one person who will understand her situation – her relative, Elizabeth, who is experiencing her own miracle of God. As soon as she sets foot in the door, even before she has time to explain her visit, Mary receives confirmation that all of this is not some fantastic dream – everything she has been told is true. She does not have to face this mixed blessing alone.

As Elizabeth proclaims the Lord's blessing upon Mary under the direction of the Holy Spirit, the enormity of what God is doing in the world through these women hits home. Mary reacts by bursting out in praise to the Lord. She acknowledges His blessing in her life and speaks of His mighty power seen throughout history in His actions toward both the righteous and the wicked. Mary recognizes the Lord's sovereignty and displays her trust in Him to do what is best for all of mankind.

What is your response to the mixed blessings of your life? An outburst of frustration and complaint or one of praise to the Lord? Trust God to provide whatever is needed and to work through you to accomplish His will in the world. You might just find that this mixed blessing is the best thing that ever could have happened to you.
