You Who Are Weary

I am worn out from groaning; all night long I flood my bed with weeping and drench my couch with tears. Psalm 6:6

"Good morning. How are you?"

"Fine, fine."

However, beneath the facade of the expected response, there is a reality which the One who first heard this lament of David, His servant, is willing and able to receive. The night has been a struggle. Sleep has not been enough to loosen the mind's grip on worries and uncertainties. Anxiety and fear parade through the mind like an endless carousel of despair.

One thing that Psalm 6 gives us is a language for times of great struggle and despair when we hardly know what to say to God and may not even have the words to pray. There is assurance here that God can hear our complaint and will indeed respond, that our groaning and weeping will not put him off. The psalmist goes on to say, "For the Lord has heard the sound of my weeping. The Lord has heard my plea; the Lord accepts my prayer."

Centuries later when Immanuel walked among us he said, "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28). Indeed, the dark night does not have the last word.

Prayer for Today: Lord, let me find your light in my darkness, your rest in my struggle, your joy in my sorrow, your grace in my sin, your riches in my poverty, your courage in my fear, your glory in my valley. In the name of Him whose promise brings hope. Amen.
