## A Promise to Keep

I, \_\_\_\_\_, take you \_\_\_\_\_, to be my lawfully wedded husband/wife. To have and to hold, from this day forward, for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness or in health, to love and to cherish 'til death do us part.

I have heard many couples repeat some version of this vow at weddings through the years. They are pledging a lifetime of devotion to one another, to the exclusion of all others. But as most of us know from personal experience, keeping that promise takes ongoing dedication and intentional effort.

As the bride of Christ, we make a similar vow when we confess Jesus as Lord and commit our lives to Him. We pledge to serve and follow Him exclusively all the days of our lives. Yet over time, we are prone to be drawn into the world around us and fail to keep our promise of single-minded allegiance to the Lord.

In Revelation 2, Jesus addresses this very issue with the church at Ephesus. He says they have forsaken their first love and instructs them to repent and do the things they did at first.

Take some time today to evaluate how well you are doing at keeping your promise of faithfulness to the Lord. If you find that you are being pulled into friendship with the world, get back on track by doing what you did as a new Christian and putting into practice the instructions given in James 4:4-10. Come near to God in humility and submission. Mourn over your sin, and purify your heart. Resist the distractions and enticements of the devil and his world.

Maybe it's time to renew those vows.
