If you find that you are being pulled into friendship with the world, get back on track by doing what you did as a new Christian and putting into practice the instructions given in James 4:4-10. Come near to God in humility and submission. Mourn over your sin, and purify your heart. Resist the distractions and enticements of the devil and his world.
