Keeping a Clear Conscience

You back your car out of the driveway and head down the street. Immediately you notice that something is not right. The car isn't picking up speed; in fact, it seems as if a giant, invisible hand is pulling on the back bumper.

Your eyes scan the dashboard in front of you, looking for a clue as to what the problem might be. Ah, there it is – a red light indicating that the parking brake is engaged. You reach down, pull the lever to release it, and go on your way.

In Acts 24:16, Paul states that he always strives to keep his conscience clear before God and man. Why? Because a guilty conscience drags us down and hinders our life journey, just like driving with the parking brake on impedes the progress of a car.

A guilty conscience consumes us and depletes our energy. David describes this in Psalm 32 – “When I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was sapped as in the heat of summer” (v. 3-4). A troubled conscience makes us listless and lethargic, causing us to be unproductive in our service to the Lord.

David's relief is apparent in verse 5 – “Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, ‘I will confess my transgressions to the Lord’ – and you forgave the guilt of my sin.” Confession acts as the lever that releases the brake of guilt. It liberates us from the shackles that restrain us, permitting us to move forward unhindered.

So if sin is burdening your soul today, take it to God and allow His forgiveness to set you free and enable you to continue on your journey with Him once again.
