Command those who are rich in this present world...
1 Timothy 6:17

Upon reading the words above of Paul to Timothy, our first thought might be, "I can just skip this part because it doesn't



apply to me. I'm not rich." So who is rich? It depends on who is used as the standard of measurement. If we compare ourselves to the millionaire in the mansion across town, we will likely see ourselves as poor. But when we consider that 80% of humanity lives on less than \$10 a day, and that almost half of the world population lives on less than \$2.50 a day, we suddenly realize that most of us who are reading this are indeed very wealthy.

So perhaps we had better back up and read this section after all. What *does* God expect from those who are rich?

In this passage, we see that some were placing their hope in wealth and trying to use God as a means to financial gain. Paul exhorts us to do just the opposite. We should instead put our hope in God and use our wealth to lay up treasure for the coming age through our generosity and willingness to share.

Which philosophy of life will you choose – trust in wealth and use God, or trust in God and use wealth? The first brings ruin and destruction; the latter gives true life.
