Worship Assembly Protocols


- If you are sick, have a compromised immune system, or feel uneasy about returning to a large group of people, please stay home and worship with us online.

Anchor for the Soul

Anchors are a part of the essential equipment found on any ship and are used for a variety of reasons and circumstances. They are dropped in tranquil waters, as when stopping for the night or waiting for a berth in port, to prevent a ship from drifting away because of slight winds, tides, or currents. Anchors are also utilized when a ship is engulfed in a storm, to avoid running aground on sandbars or being dashed against protruding rocks.



The writer of Hebrews compares our hope in Christ to a ship's anchor. During peaceful times we, like the unanchored ship, are in danger of drifting away from God because of the subtle pull of the world around us. Our hope in Christ keeps us where we should be.

In the storms of life, we also, like the ship, are at risk of running aground and becoming lodged on a sandbar of discouragement or being broken apart by the sharp rocks of grief or despair. Our hope in the Lord will hold us steady and help us ride out the storm.

Through this imagery "...we who have fled to take hold of the hope offered to us may be greatly encouraged" (Hebrews 6:18).
