#### Chosen

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God...

#### 1 Peter 2:9

The classic movie, *Roman Holiday*, is the story of a young princess who grows tired of the duties and restrictions that come with being royalty. So while visiting her country's embassy in Rome, she decides to sneak out and see what life is like as an ordinary citizen. Although she enjoys her twenty-four hours of freedom on the streets of Rome, she eventually comes to understand and appreciate not only the benefits, but also the responsibilities, of being one who is specially chosen.



A key thought of Ephesians 1:3-14 is that as Christians, we are chosen by God. Upon hearing, believing, and obeying the gospel, we become royalty, marked with the seal of the Holy Spirit. As Paul points out in this passage, belonging to God brings amazing benefits – every spiritual blessing we need, adoption as sons and daughters, abundant grace and redemption, forgiveness of sins, and great wisdom and understanding – all made possible through His Son, Jesus Christ. As God's elect, we are blessed beyond measure.

Along with these privileges, however, come responsibilities as well. We are called to be holy and blameless in His sight. But rather than see this expectation as a burden we must bear, we can learn to find joy in bringing honor and glory to our Father and King through living holy lives. We exist "for the praise of His glory."

So today, find joy in the benefits and responsibilities of being chosen by God.
